Submission Information:
The author(s) of each accepted digital poster will be expected to be present at the 2018 American Orff-Schulwerk Association Conference to discuss their project with other attendees during the digital poster event, and are encouraged to provide a handout with their abstract and references for distribution at the session. Poster submissions may have been presented at other conferences.

Only electronic displays will be permitted (PowerPoint, Prezi, Keynote, or another appropriate presentation software) on a personal laptop or tablet. Researchers are responsible for providing their own equipment and power supply/battery. Tables will be provided.

Submission Guidelines:

- Submit a summary in an abstract of up to 500 words describing your research submission; please submit in pdf or Word format.
- Please do not include any identifying information in your abstract file. Instead, save the file with a descriptive term from your title, without your name or other identifying information, followed by DigitalAOSA (e.g., ImprovisationStudyDigitalAOSA.pdf).
- In the body of an email or on a separate cover sheet, please include your name, affiliation (university, public school, private school, charter school), address, email, and title of the study.

Deadline for Submissions:

The submission deadline will be April 1, 2018. Notification of acceptance will be made to the primary author by April 15, 2018.
