



Tips for Grant Applicants

Please consider the following when completing your scholarship or grant applications:

1. We feel blessed to work with such talented educators and are amazed at your accolades. For the purpose of this application a one page resume will suffice.
2. Ask a colleague or another Orff Schulwerk teacher to proofread your application. Even the most talented writers have editors to ensure their work is ready for publication. **Complete all fields.**
3. The AutoCorrect feature makes some very interesting suggestions to words it doesn't know well – especially words like “Schulwerk” and “Carl Orff.”
(Those are really important words to spell correctly.)
4. Ask the people who are writing references to address the following:
 - Detail their relationship with you
 - The purpose of the application
 - How has Orff Schulwerk impacted your teaching
5. Possible references could be:
 - People who are familiar with your teaching, even a colleague or chapter leader
 - A Levels instructor
 - A department head or supervisor
6. You are encouraged to speak from the heart. It's okay to tell us your story!
